

What animals can the Wildlife Rehabilitation Center care for?

The ARL Wildlife Rehabilitation Center is licensed to care for most native species. All songbirds, birds of prey and most mammals are accepted. A limited number of Rabies Vector Species, including raccoons, groundhogs, fox, skunks and bats can be admitted. If you have found one of these animals, please call to see if we have open cages. If we do not, we will do our best to refer you to another rehabilitator with open cages.

The Center cannot accept or care for White tailed Deer. Due to our suburban location, we do not have enough outdoor space to appropriately care for these animals. We can refer you to another rehabilitator.

The Center does not accept domestic animals, including domestic ducks, geese, pocket pets, domestic reptiles and domestic birds.
